Believe Small Group Guide Session 13

Key Verse: Read the key verse together. *Do your best to present yourself to God as one approved, a worker who does not need to be ashamed, and correctly handles the word or truth.* (2 *Timothy* 2:15)

Key Idea: I study the Bible to know God and his truth and to find direction for my daily life.

Group Discussion

As a group, discuss your thoughts and feelings about the following declarations. Which statement are easy to declare with certainty? Which are more challenging, and why?

- I read the Bible daily.
- I regularly study the Bible to find direction for my life.
- I seek to be obedient to God by applying the truth of the Bible to my life.
- I have a good understanding of the contents of the Bible.

Go through the following questions. Feel free to go through all of them or just a few based on your group size and time restraints.

1) As a group, make a list of reasons or motivations someone could possess for studying the Bible. Discuss which reasons are most compelling.

2) What obstacles usually hinder a person from practicing consistent Bible study? Discuss ways to overcome these challenges.

3) In what ways has the Bible proven a trustworthy map for navigating decisions in your life?

4) Many tools – devotionals, commentaries, reading plans, etc. – can help people get the most out of their Bible reading. As a group, discuss some of the tools that you have found helpful.

Read Psalm 119:9-24

1) What are some practical ways to "hide God's word in your heart"?

2) Discuss what it means for God's word to be a "lamp for your feet and a light on your path".

3) The psalmist declares the he loves God's law and precepts. Do we feel the same way?

Close your time together with prayer. Share your prayer requests with one another. Ask God to help you put this week's key idea into practice.
